EPIPHANY MEN'S CLUB SCHOLARSHIP

Dear Epiphany Parishioner,

This scholarship is sponsored by the Epiphany Men's Club for the sole purpose of rewarding a parishioner for his/her scholastic achievements and involvement in church activities. The scholarship is offered to any registered parishioner who is presently attending or has been accepted as a full time undergraduate student (minimum 12 hours) to a 2-year or 4-year college/university. A recipient may receive a scholarship a maximum of four years but must reapply each year.

The \$1,500 John Lynn Scholarship will be payable in two installments of \$750 each with the second installment payable at the beginning of the spring semester. The recipient is required to show proof of maintaining a 2.5 grade point average for a minimum of 12 semester hours and show proof of enrollment as a full time student (minimum of 12 hours) in the spring semester in order to receive the second installment. The second installment will be held open through the first nine weeks of the second semester. Additional scholarships of various amounts may also be awarded, under these same guidelines.

The deadline for submitting this application is 9 pm on Sunday, June 29th. Applications should be emailed to youth@epiphanyokc.org. Late or incomplete applications will not be considered.

An application will be considered complete when it has been received and signed by Sarah Holt and/or Fr. Stephen Bird and includes an official high school transcript (if applying for the first time), and/or college transcript (print-out of grades) for the previous semester.

Scholarship recipients will be notified in July.

Men's Club Scholarship FAQ

Who can apply?

The John Lynn Scholarship and other scholarships are open to any registered parishioner who is attending or planning to attend a full-time program at a 2-year or 4-year university or college. Students must take a minimum of 12 hours and maintain at least a 2.5 grade point average to be eligible and receive scholarship disbursements.

How many scholarships are awarded? How much are they?

The Men's Club awards one \$1,500 scholarship every fall, as well as additional scholarships of various amounts.

What criteria do you consider when awarding scholarships?

Scholarships are awarded based upon scholastic achievement, parish involvement and financial need. The Scholarship Committee also takes into consideration the student's parental involvement at the parish, as well as household income.

How is the scholarship paid?

Scholarships are paid in two installments. The first installment is paid before the start of the fall semester and the second installment before the start of the spring semester, as long as the student maintains a 2.5 GPA and shows proof of grades and enrollment in at least 12 hours. The payments are made by a mailed check.

Can you re-apply every year?

Yes. Students who are awarded scholarships for one school year must re-apply to be considered for subsequent years.

When is the deadline to apply?

The deadline for submitting this application is 9pm on Sunday, June 30th. Applications may be emailed to youth@epiphanyokc.org. Late or incomplete applications will not be considered.

When will I find out if I receive a scholarship?

Awards will be finalized in July. All applicants will be notified thereafter.

How does the Men's Club fund scholarships?

The Men's Club funds scholarships and other parish activities by performing Casino Night, Bingo and other entertainment fundraisers.
